

Convenient for Wales, the UK and beyond

Bridgend is a key logistical centre for Wales, the UK and beyond.

Situated along the M4 corridor, midway between Cardiff and Swansea, the town is bordered by the spectacular Heritage Coast to the south and the glorious countryside of the Vale of Glamorgan to the east.

The nearby M4 and A48 roads provide quick and easy access to Britain's motorway network, while regular direct rail services to London, Birmingham and other major UK cities operate daily. Cardiff International Airport is just 20 minutes away by road and provides direct scheduled passenger services to the UK and mainland Europe, as well as charter flights to North America. The busy seaports of Newport, Cardiff, Barry and Swansea lie along the South Wales coastline, just a short journey away.

How to find Waterton Park

Via M4 Motorway

Leave Junction 35 M4 Motorway (Junction 36 can be used for approach from Eire and West Wales but this is not the preferred junction).

From the west, take the third left at the roundabout and follow the dual carriageway towards Bridgend for approximately one mile.

From the east, take the first left at the roundabout and follow the dual carriageway towards Bridgend for approximately one mile.

Turn left at the second roundabout and then first right at the next roundabout.

Proceed past the Ford Motor Company plant and Waterton Park is located 200 metres on left hand side of road.

Via A48 Trunk Road

From Swansea, go through the Waterton roundabout and turn left at traffic lights alongside the Bridgend Ford dealership. Proceed for 100 metres and Waterton Park is adjacent to the next roundabout.

From Cardiff, proceed past Brocastle Business Park and turn right at the traffic lights alongside Bridgend Ford dealership. Proceed for 100 metres and Waterton Park is adjacent to the next roundabout.
